MSW Course Work

- 1. 63 credits of MSW course work must be competed, electives must include:

 - **SW595** (Child and Adolescent Assessment and Diagnosis)
 - Choose 2 electives from the following list:
 - o SW425, SW438, SW462, SW482, SW483, SW528, SW566,

or SW582

Note: Students are required to remain flexible in their schedules in order to meet all course requirements. In some instances, an additional semester may be required to meet all requirements.
