Dear School Library Teacher Concentration Students:

Welcome to Simmons and the School of Library and Information Science. I am delighted you have chosen the School Library Teacher Program (SLTP) and I look forward to working with you.

Students in the SLTP engage with a curriculum that includes coursework, field experience, and two program culminating practicums that adhere to the Massachusetts Department of Elementary and Secondary Education (DESE) <u>Guidelines for Program Approval</u> and that reflect the DESE's <u>Professional Standards for Teachers</u> and the <u>Subject Matter Knowledge</u> associated with school library media specialization. To prepare for their practicum experiences, SLT students follow a <u>distinct program of study</u> that begins in their first semester. As you prepare to register for your first semester at SLIS in the SLTP, it is important to keep the following in mind:

- LIS Virtual Orientation: <u>LIS 400-OL</u> is required for all LIS students (no-credit, no-cost)
- <u>LIS Core Curriculum</u>: The two required core courses listed below should be among the first four classes you register for and complete at SLIS:
  - LIS 407: Information Sources and Services
  - LIS 415: Information Organization
- LIS 459 Fundamentals of School Librarianship (formerly SLT Pre-Practicum Field Experience) LIS 459 should be among the first three classes SLTP students register for and complete
- All MSLIS students have a technology requirement. As an SLT student, your requirement is **LIS 460: Technology for the School Librarian**, rather than LIS 488 which most students will take. You and your advisor will work together in your first semester to schedule this and other SLT coursework.

## Full-time vs. Part-time Registration

If you are planning to study **full-time**, you should plan to register for 3 LIS classes (9 credits) per semester. We recommend that you register for LIS 459 and the 2 LIS core courses noted above.

If you are planning to study **part-time**, you should plan to register for 1 or 2 LIS classes (3 or 6 credits) each semester. We recommend that you register for LIS 407 and/or LIS 415 and plan to take LIS 459 once you have completed these two LIS core requirements.
