COVID-19

Q. Are there provisions to help students stay up to date if they have to quarantine? i.e. join class via zoom?

A. If a student needs to quarantine or isolate they should reach out to their faculty members to make arrangements for each course. If they need assistance with that because they are feeling ill they can reach out to Student Affairs studentaffairs@simmons.edu

Q. Are students who test positive for COVID-19 being housed in the dorms

A. If a student tests positive for COVID-19 and they live within 200 miles of Simmons they should plan to isolate at home. For students who live further than 200 miles from campus we have a limited number of designated isolation rooms in the residence hall where they would be relocated for the isolation period.

Q. What is the difference between isolation and quarantine?

A. Isolation is for students who have tested positive for COVID-19. Quarantine is used when someone has been exposed but has not tested positive. Both require students to remain away from others for a period of time, however per CDC guidelines, quarantine for exposure is no longer required if the exposed person is vaccinated. Isolation is still required if a person is positive for COVID-19.

Q. I would like to know more about guests from other colleges? Is there is sign in? How do the other students know that there are guests on their floor? Do male guests use the bathroom facilities on the floor? How is this managed?
