Introduction

This document provides information about the course rotation for the School of Library and Information Science at Simmons University. This document does not constitute a guarantee of course offerings but demonstrates how we work to plan our course offerings. It is arranged according to the way our curriculum is structured. The core courses are listed first and then each concentration's required and elective option courses are listed. The concentrations are followed by a list of courses that are not part of a concentration but are still available in our curriculum. Doctoral courses are also included. Following the rotation information reflecting our concentration structures, there is a single list by course number as an index.

Frequency conventions

- "Every semester" refers to Fall and Spring semesters
- The designation "once a year" means that a single section will be available; the designation "twice a year" means that two sections will be available. That does not necessarily mean multiple semesters.

Modality conventions

- The modality column refers to modality offerings. They are not tied to specific semesters because that is dependent on instructor availability and preferences.
- The "OL" designation covers online synchronous and online asynchronous modalities. Whether a course is synchronous or asynchronous is dependent on instructor availability and preference.
- Practicum courses have an X modality identification to indicate that they are practica. Practica have a site placement and an online academic component.

The SLIS summer schedule is established each year based on instructor availability and preferences and therefore is not included in this course rotation with the exception of the two courses we offer that are currently only offered in the Summer (LIS 447 Collection maintenance and LIS 452 History of Libraries).
