

Notes

- Major requires at least 32 semester hours.
- Students are encouraged to study abroad but are expected to take a minimum of 16 credits of course work in the department, including at least 4 credits upon their return from study abroad. Otherwise, students are expected to take all classes for the major at Simmons with the possibility of transferring courses by petition and only in extreme hardship. Granada travel courses are considered Simmons courses.
- Normally, no more than 4 credits of departmental courses given in English may be credited toward the major.
- Proficiency in a second modern language beyond the intermediate level is strongly recommended for all Spanish majors.
